

Joy Call Committee Report for Annual Meeting

Joy's Call Committee has been diligently at work learning both the ELCA Call Process and determining the desires and needs of Joy Lutheran Church. We have solicited information from current, past and non-worshipping members. We have been looking at past annual reports, current neighborhood statistics and Joy's constitution.

We are first tasked with preparing a Ministry Site Profile (MSP) which will be approved by the congregation and then distributed to potential Pastoral Candidates. The MSP is taking shape with several sections complete and several more in process. Information which includes; Joy's Purpose, Giftedness, Mission and Vision are all part of the MSP. One section asks us to describe both the gifts for ministry and the style of leadership that we require in a leader. The congregation will be polled for this section both in a Temple Talk and by phone. The new Joy Council will be preparing the financial package portion of the MSP. The congregations' input and approval for the completed MSP will be forthcoming after Easter. When all is complete the MSP goes to the Bishop for final approval and distribution. The next step for the Call Committee includes Candidate interviews and selection. The candidate will then be presented to the congregation for acceptance. Your input, observations and thoughts are valuable.
